BARI Mobility Programme

- BARI (Baltic Science Network Mobility Programme for Research Internships) offers **doctoral students** the possibility to host **Master or Bachelor students** from the BSR for a research internship from 2 weeks to 3 months.
→ Aim: Bringing together early career and future researchers in the BSR
- Two elements:
 1. Matching platform that brings together students and hosts (financed by Interreg BSN Powerhouse)
 2. Stipend scheme for students (financed by 12 sponsors including CBSS PSF)

BARI Mobility Programme

- 60 internships were realized from July 2020 – July 2021, despite the pandemic
- Hosting organisations represented 8 countries: DE (21), DK (2), EE (5), FI (8), LT (3), NO (1), PL (8), SE (12).
- Sending organisations came from 7 countries: DE (21), EE (2), FI(5), LT (3), PL (12), RU (13), SE (4).
- Evaluation showed high satisfaction of participants (hosts and students).
- BARI Programme is a highly flexible and efficient tool.
- Funding scheme with 12 different funding agencies from national and regional level successfully piloted.

Future Plans

- BARI Pilot is now completed, concept has been revised
 1. BSN seeks for new funding for a full restart of BARI Programme (e.g. Interreg, ERSMUS plus, ...)
 2. Small Mobility Programme similar to BARI currently piloted with HALOS programme in ÖKS-Hamburg region
- Best Practice for cooperation between different programmes, initiatives and funding agencies.
